things around Shawnee...



The **Horses in the City Tour** is a self-guided driving tour which features the nearly 30 public art horses which were installed to celebrate the Oklahoma State Centennial. Each horse is hand-painted by local artists; they each share a unique story. Maps available at Celebration event.



At the **Mabee-Gerrer Museum of Art** step back in time and view Oklahoma's only ancient Egyptian mummies or view art and artifacts collected from Europe, Africa and South America. For more details go to: mgmoa.org

>> The Heart of Oklahoma Exhibition Center

The exhibition center offers a large convention hall and seven conference rooms for tech sessions, non-tech sessions, group/club gatherings, etc. Adjacent to the Center is a beautiful RV park.

The Center is located on Interstate 40 in Shawnee, Oklahoma and is just 30 minutes east of the attractions in downtown Oklahoma City. The physical address is 1700 W. Independence, Shawnee, OK 74804; Lon: -96.9483; Lat: 35.34953. The mailing address is PO Box 1466, Shawnee, OK 74804.

When arriving at the Center, we ask that you follow the signs to registration. If you arrive after 5:00 pm, please park in an unoccupied site and register in the morning. Note...you may need to move once registered.

“Mac the Fire Guy”

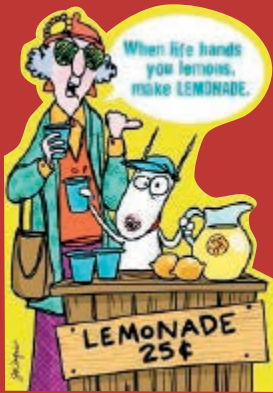


An RV fire is a terrifying prospect and if you've never experienced one, you probably don't appreciate how quickly it can get out of control.

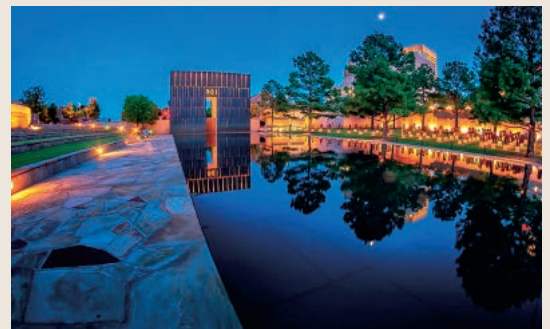
Pre-Celebration Offerings
