
## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## **AUXILIARY DRAIN PAN**


- Remove Air Conditioner from box and place upside-down on its top. Be careful not to slide unit on top to avoid damage to shroud.
- 2. Measure up from front edge of roof gasket 6 3/4" and cut out, down to unit base pan, a 1/2" section of the roof gasket on each side.




- 3. On Penguin style units ONLY
  - a. Remove 2" square foam blocks next to drain openings.
  - b. Remove one 5/16" Hex head screw on left side of base pan near drain opening.
- 4. Add foam strips
  - a. To Penguin style units as shown above.
  - On BriskAir and Quick Cool units place strips one on top of other and place at bottom back edge of base pan.
- 5. Place assembly down over drain holes.
  - a. Seal below and above each drain tube, where it goes through the roof gasket, with a good all weather sealant.
  - b. Place assembly in direction with the inside drain on either the right or left side of 14" opening which ever is best for your application.
  - c. The straight edge of drain pan goes tight to roof gasket.
  - d. Holes in drain pan fit over the screw protruding from bottom of unit base pan toward front of unit.

NOTE: Do Not seal edges of drain pan to base pan with sealant. When left unsealed this will act as secondary drain in event primary drain becomes clogged.

## **Penguin Style units Only**



6. Install self drilling screw through drain pans and into base pan to hold drain pans to base pan. Use two (2) screws per pan.



- 7. Install new roof gasket on top of current roof gasket on unit.
- 8. Turn unit back over and install in the normal manner per unit installation instructions.
- Connect 1/2" inside diameter hose to drain pan connection and run out of 14: opening and down the RV wall.

**NOTE:** For best draining, keep 1/2" I.D. hose flat, DO NOT allow it to hump up.
