Driving Practice Notes

1. You will need to use YOUR GMC. That is the one you will be driving, so that is the one you need to be familiar with. There have been many changes to most of them and that makes each one different than the others.
2. Before the practice, sit in the drivers' seat to get familiar with how you need to adjust everything to fit you. Just like you do in a car.
3. Make sure everything in your GMC is secure, just as you would before taking it on the road.
4. If you would be more comfortable with your primary driver with you, that is ok. However, there are those who get upset easily (if you don't do things as they would do things) and then you get upset and nervous, and the practice becomes not fun, and not very helpful for you. So far, everyone has driven alone, except for one lady who had her dog in the coach. There will be people on the course to help direct you.
5. The parking lot course will be designed to give you practice in backing into a parking spot as you would at a campground; turning both right and left around traffic cones to help get used to how much room it takes when turning; other maneuvers for practice in using your mirrors, and just getting used to how your coach feels. This is NOT a competition.
