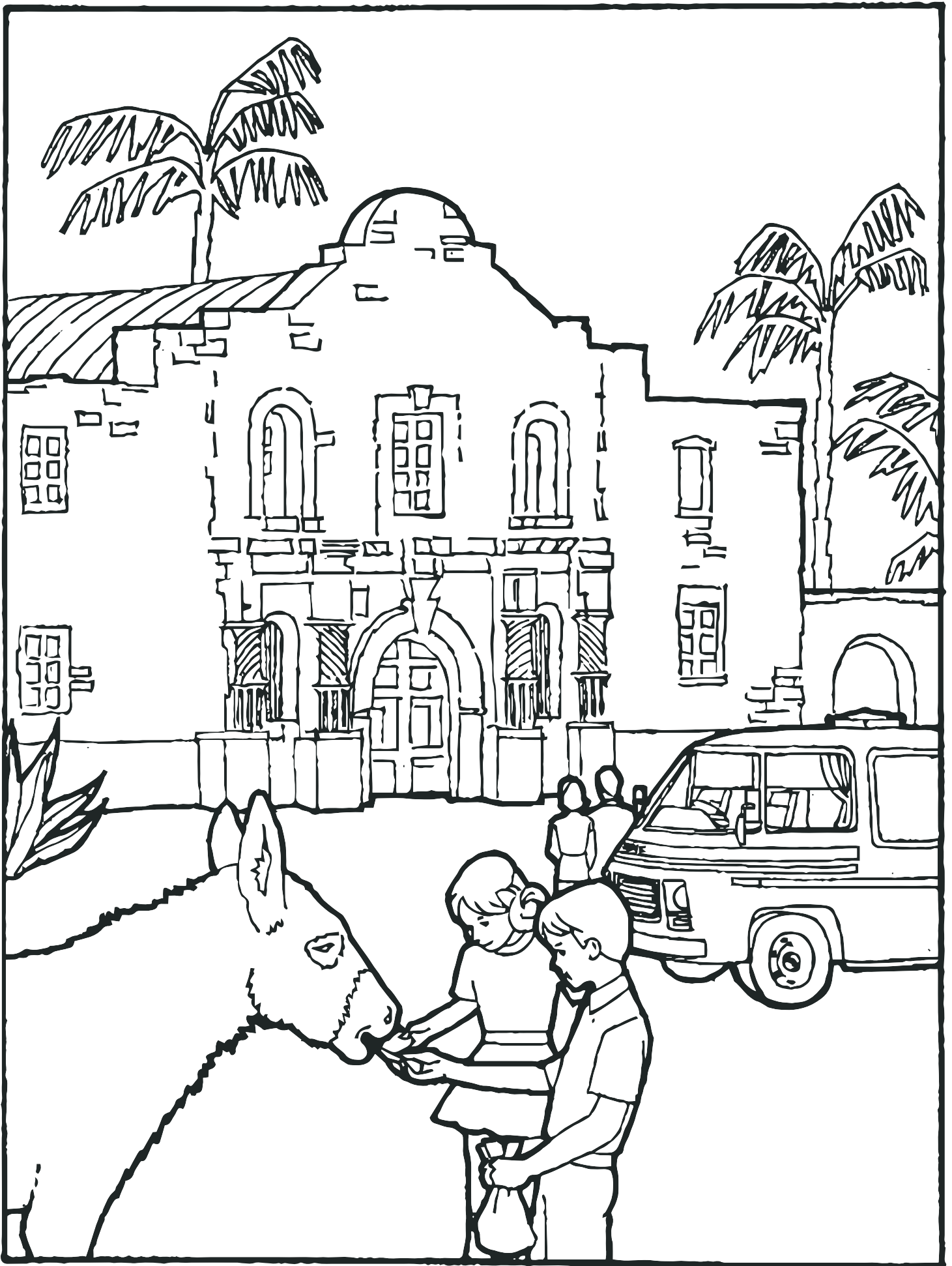




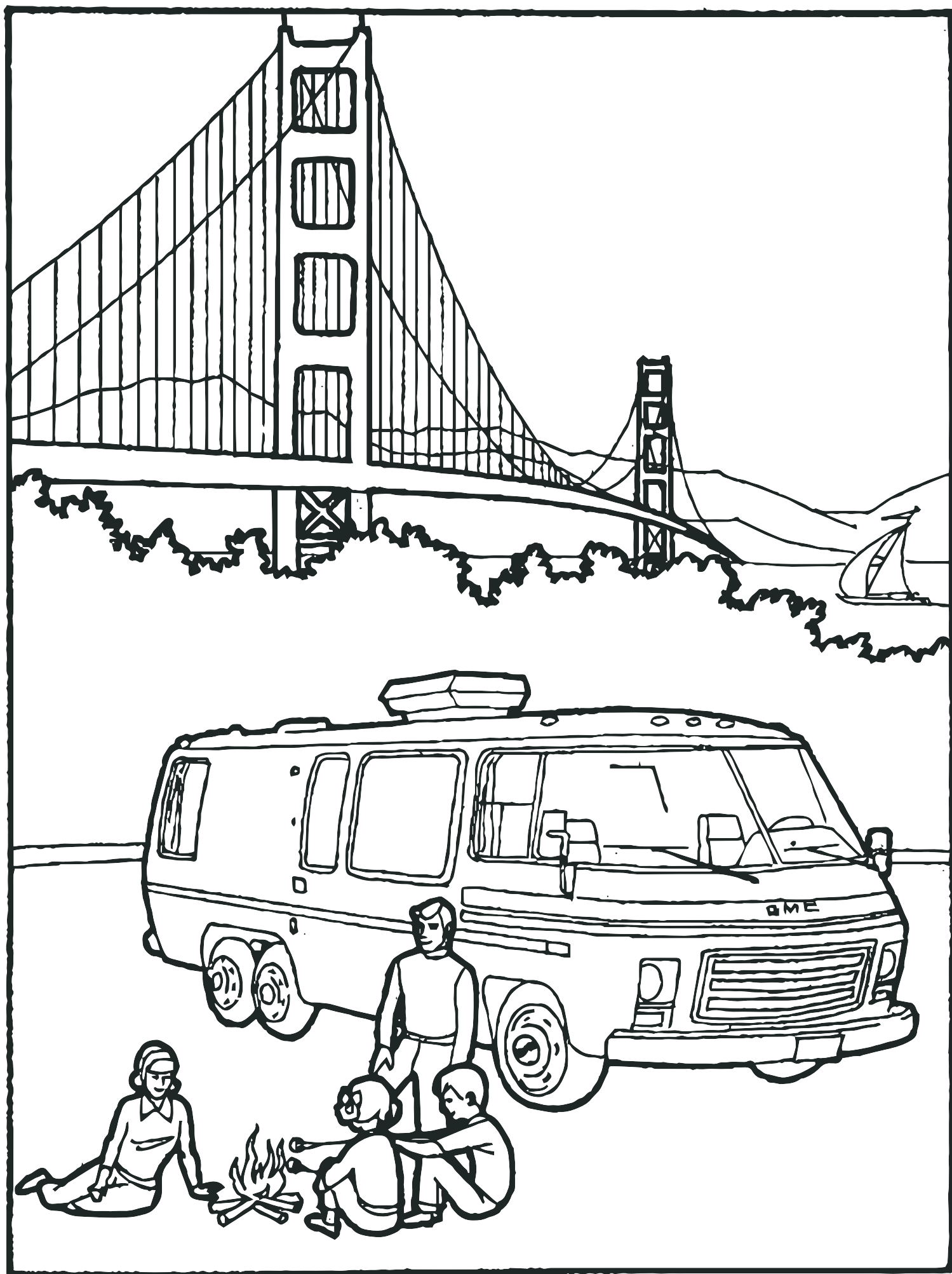
A MOTHER BEAR AND HER CUB BEG FOR FOOD
IN GLACIER PARK--DON'T FEED THEM.



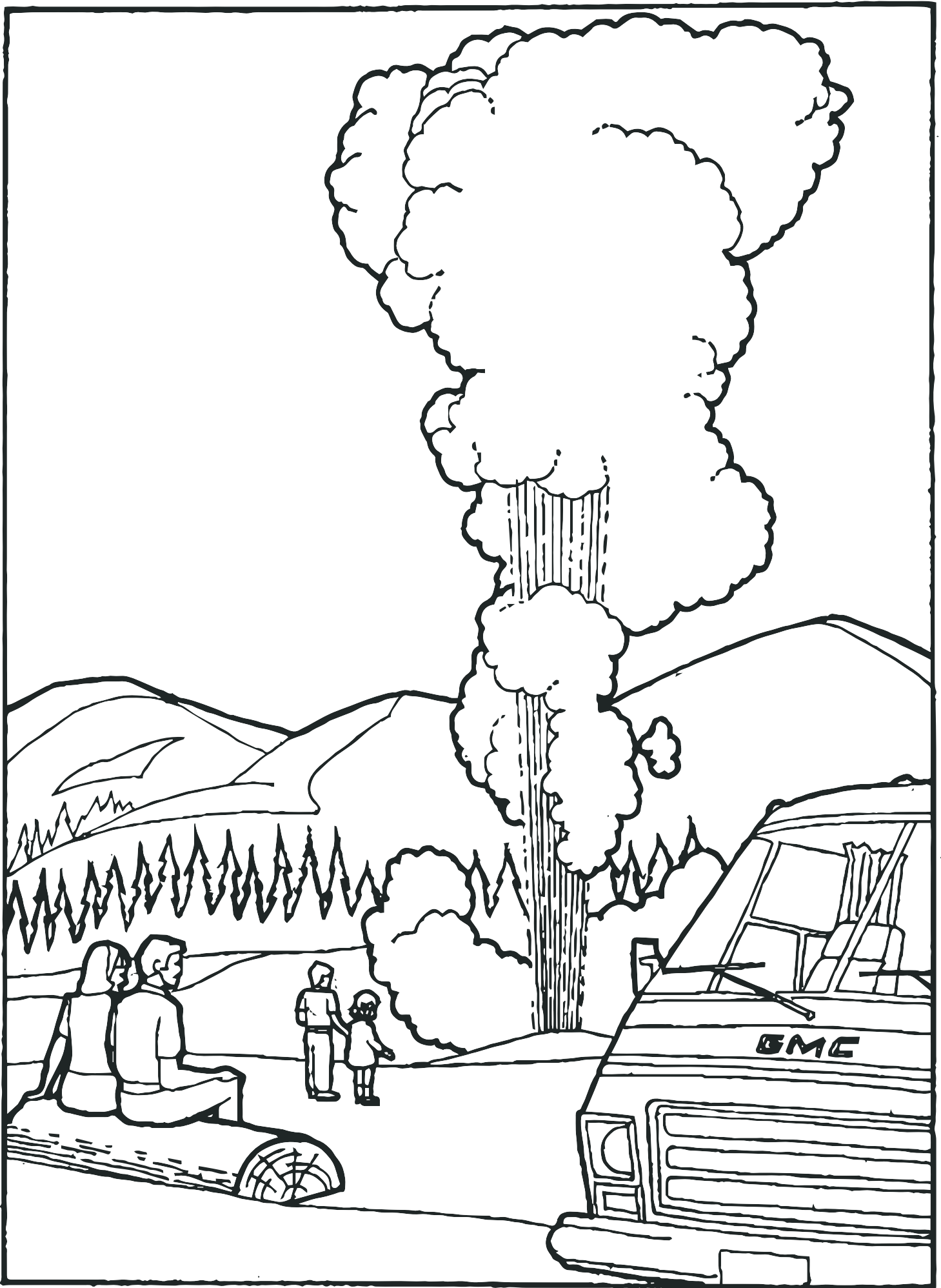

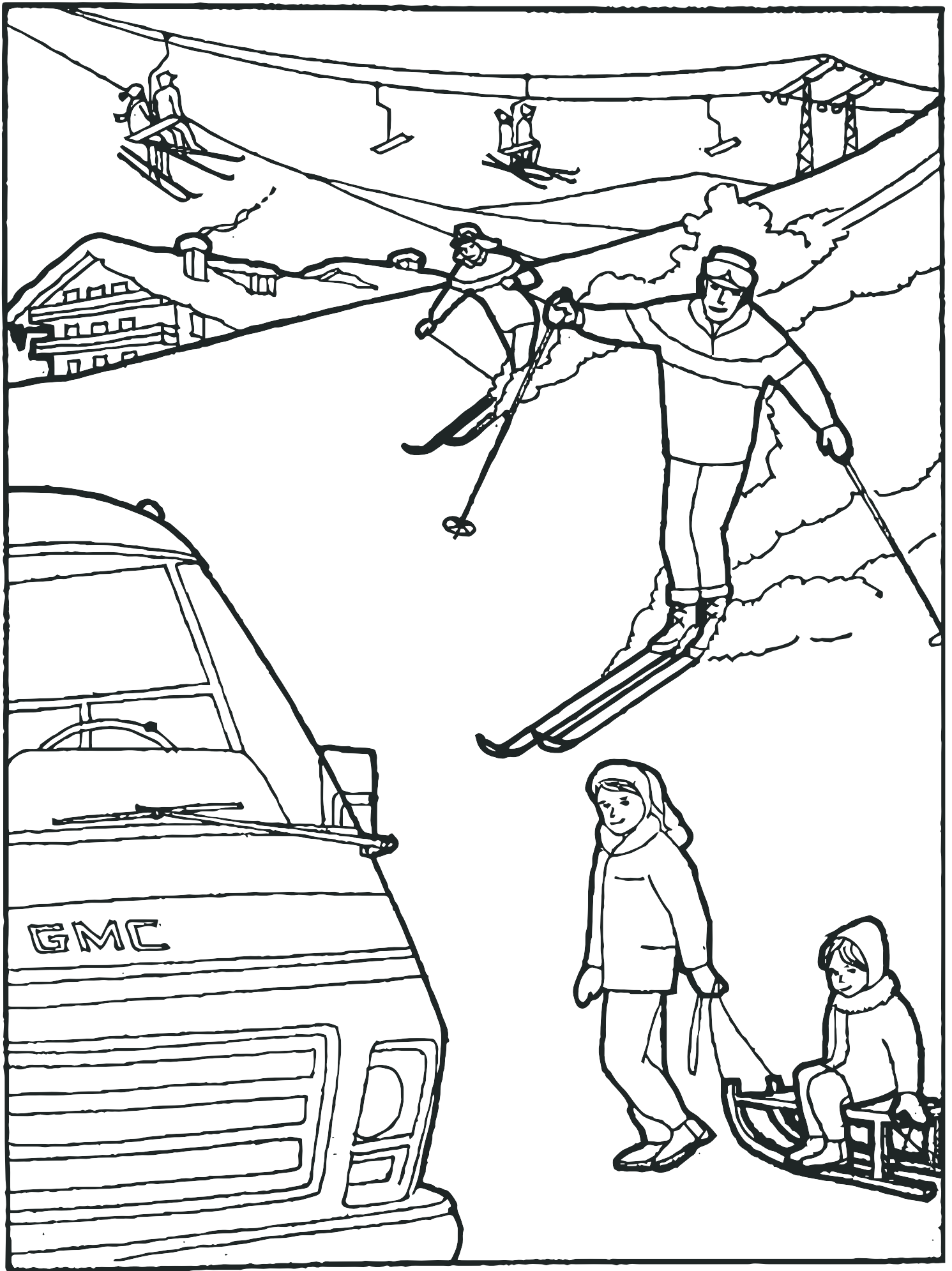

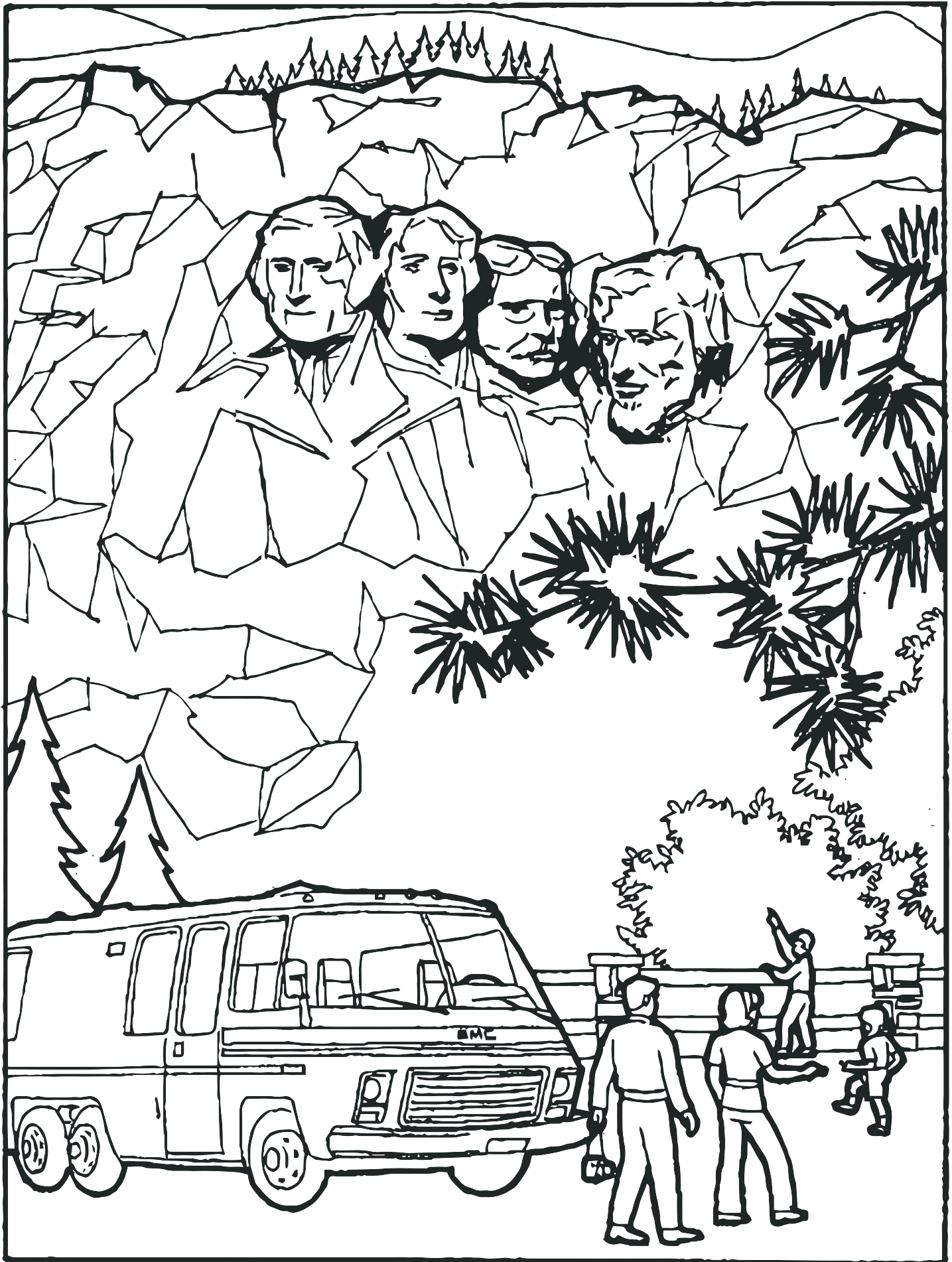
MARSHMALLOWS IN THE SHADOW OF GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE, SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA.



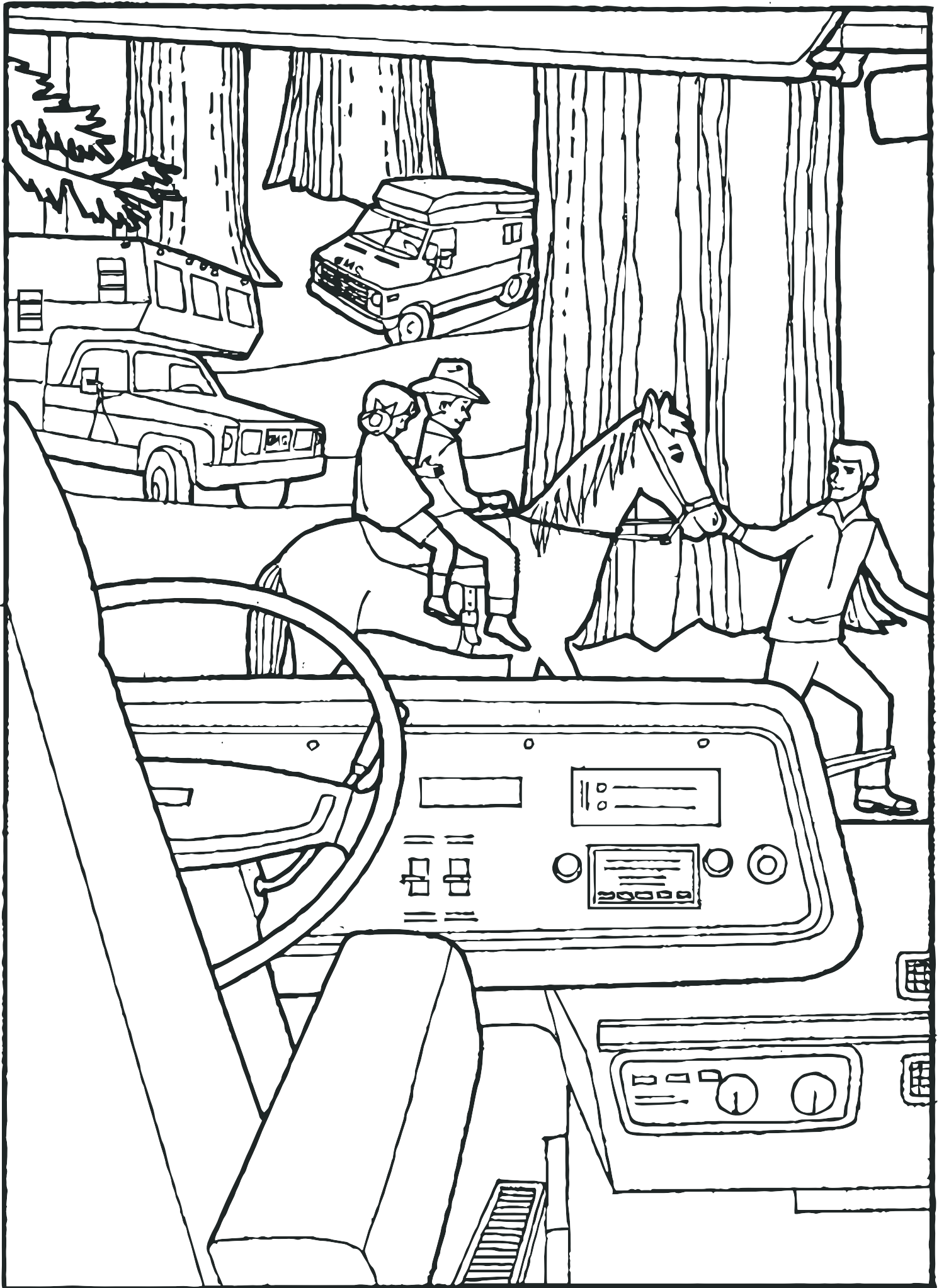
OLD FAITHFUL SENDS A PLUME OF STEAM 150 FEET IN THE AIR IN YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK.



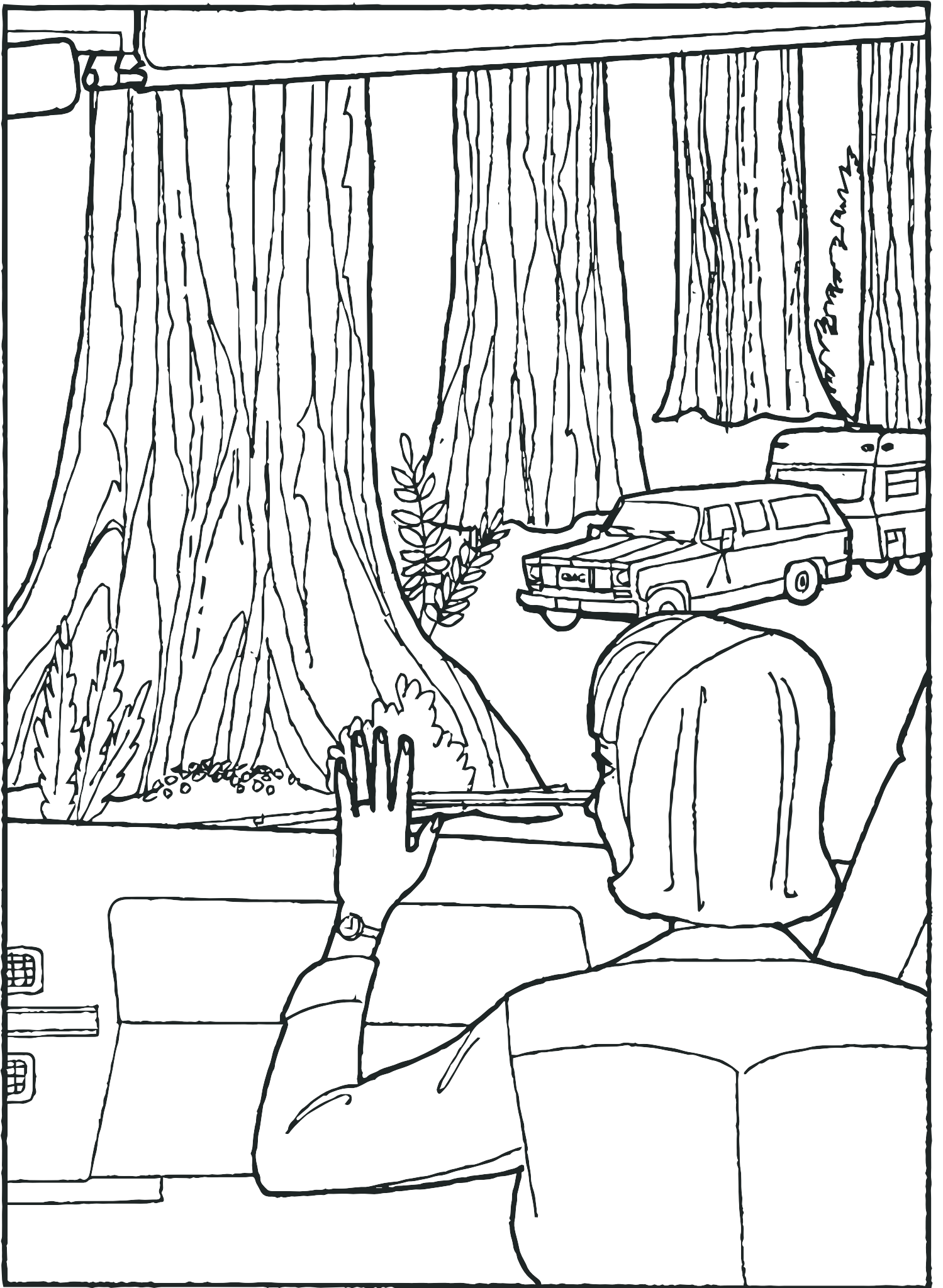

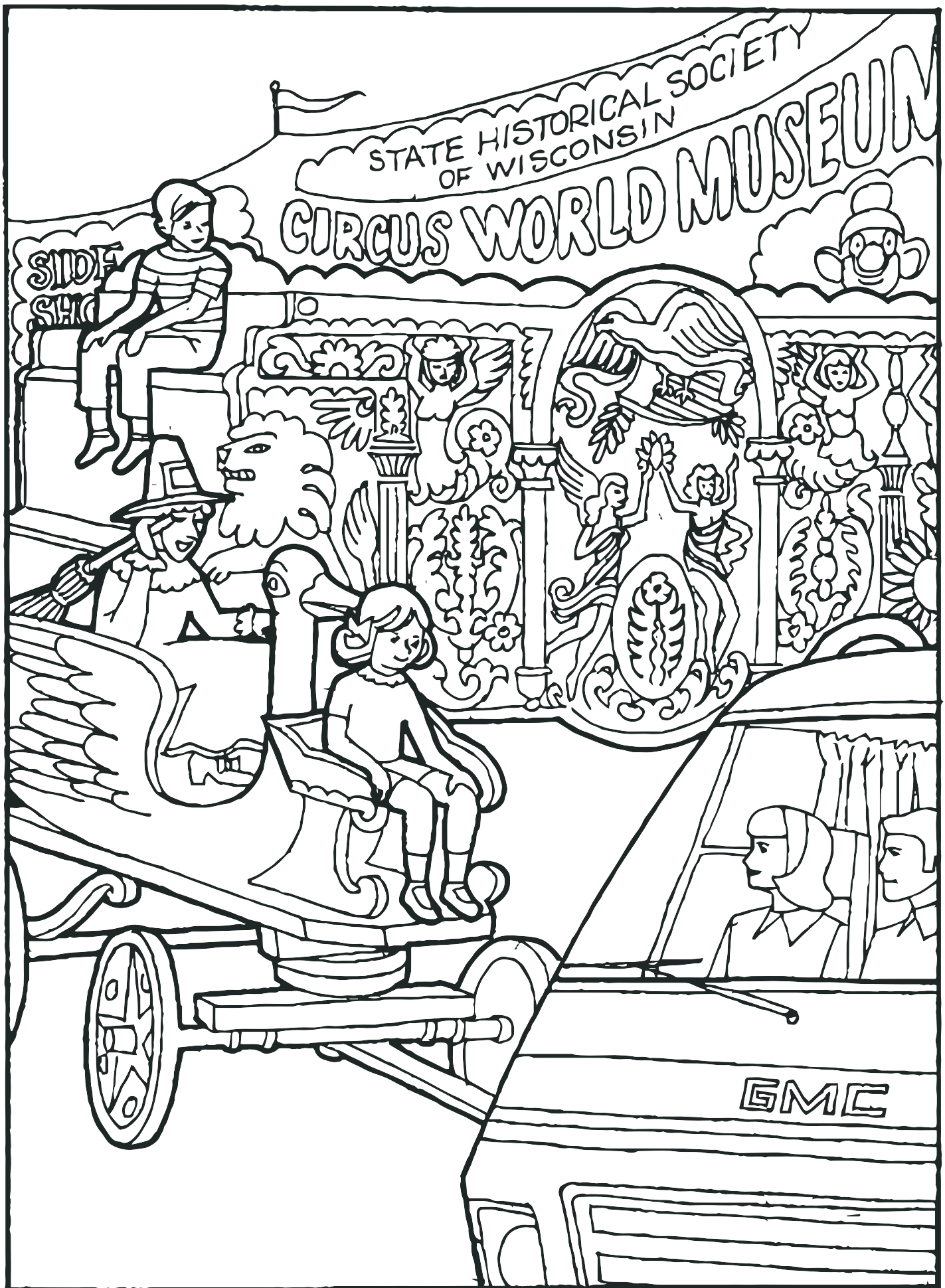

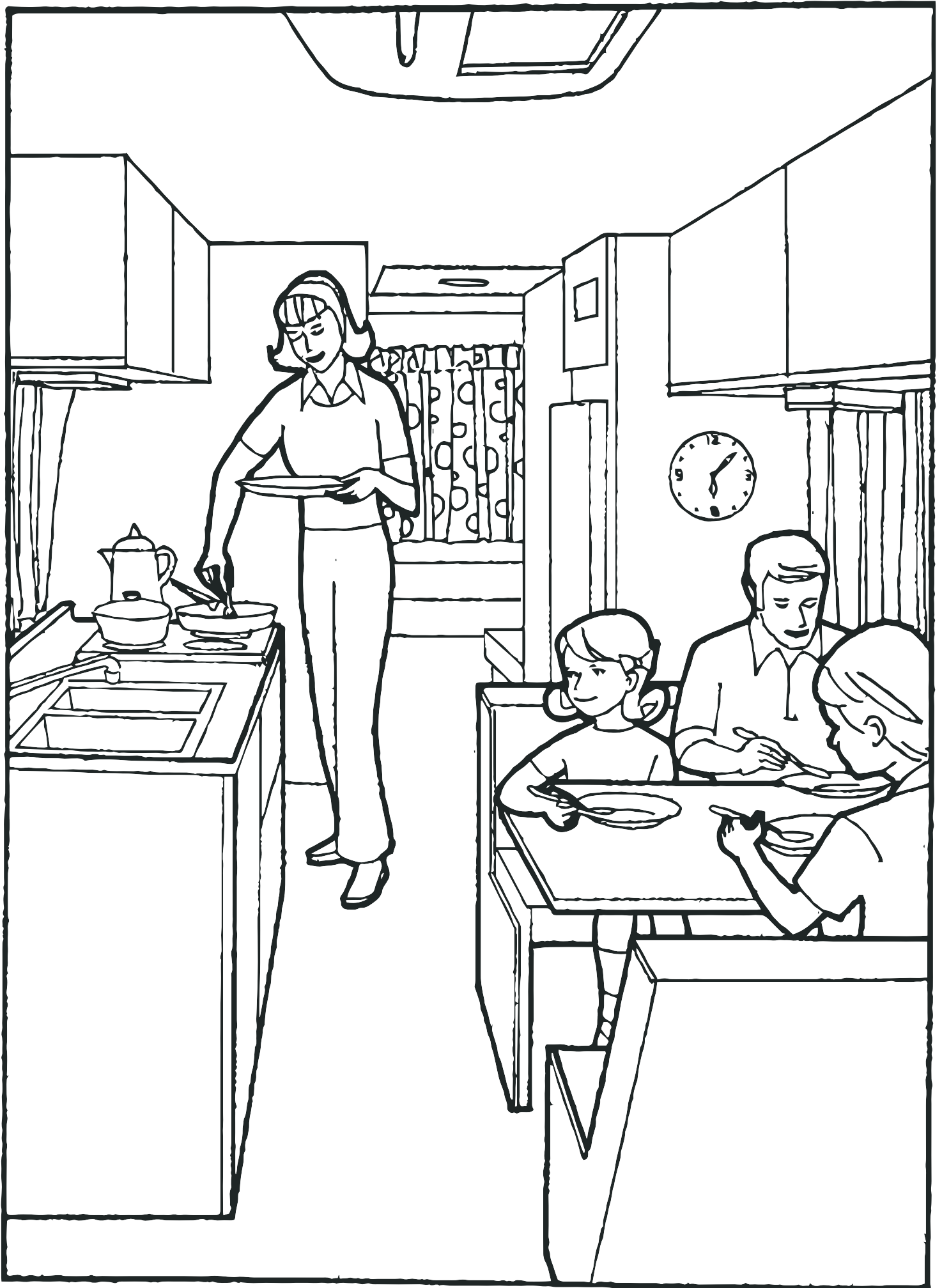

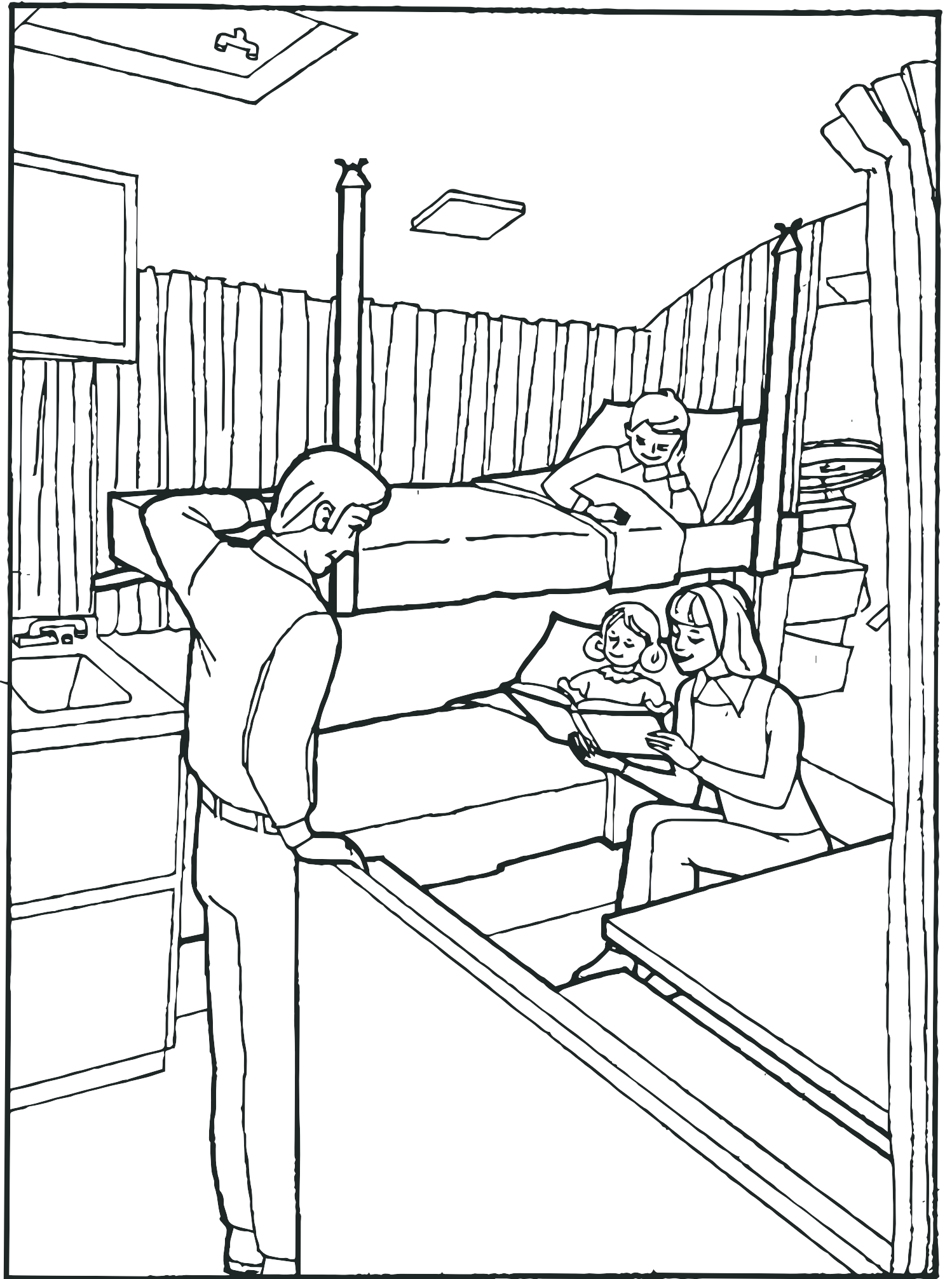

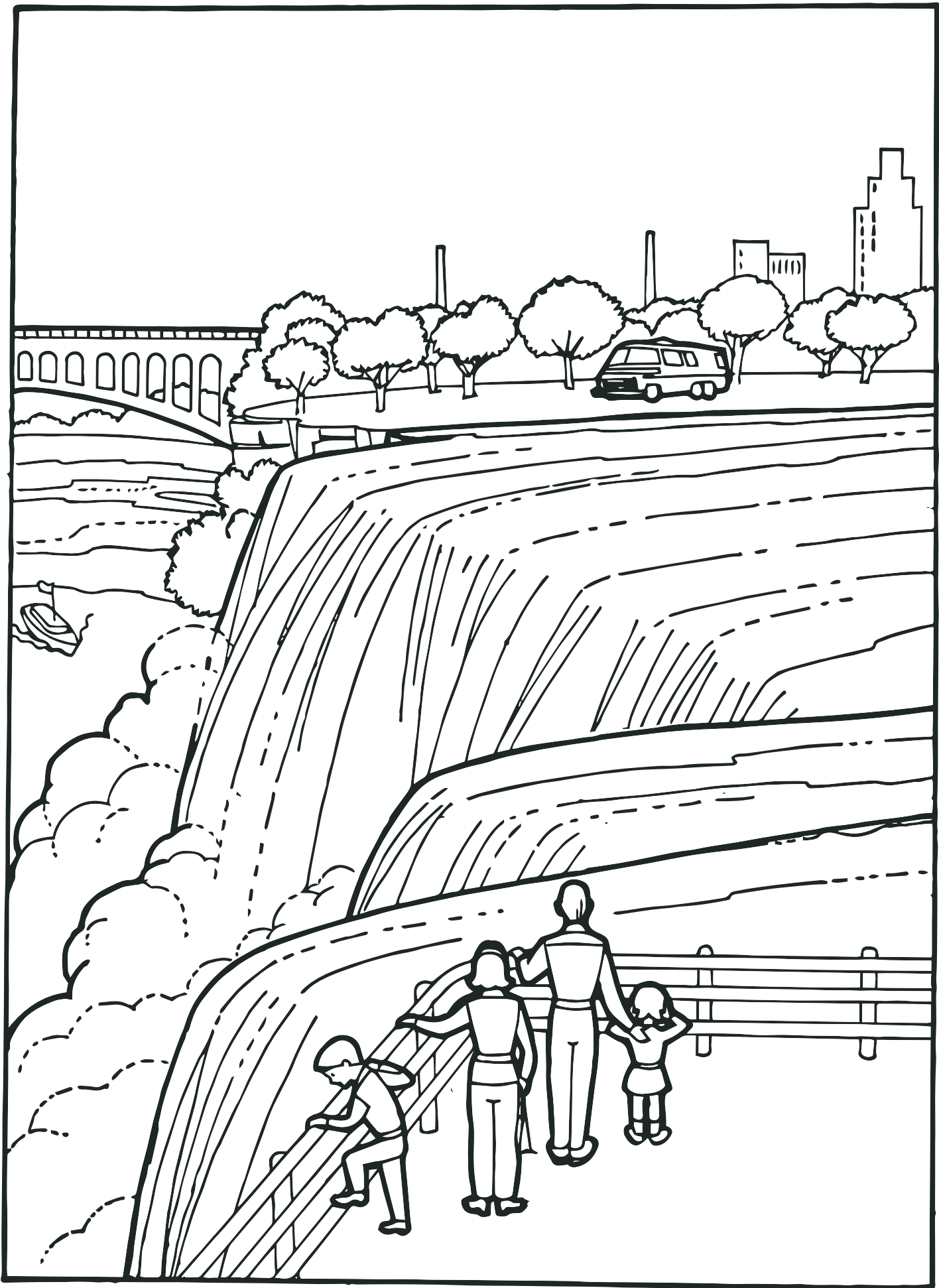
